Engaging students in service-learning and leadership development opportunities is one of the most important factors in the maturity of the next generation. Developing students' character to be productive citizens is one of the most important factors in creating tomorrow's global communities. Swamp Corps is a camp-based training program that addresses both of these issues. With your help, we can prepare the next generation.

This January, Swamp Corps began its 13th year of successful service-learning operations. In 2010, we went on our charter trip to Jamaica where 33 U.S. students and 77 Jamaican campers met in the mountains for an amazing initial week. Since then, we have traveled to Barbados, South Africa, Brazil, India, Bahamas, Zimbabwe, Kenya, Middle East, Nicaragua, Honduras, Mozambique, and Cambodia spanning four continents providing over 8,400 camping opportunities for children ages 9-18 and over 800 students ages 14-23 a service-learning trip. Even during COVID, a Virtual Camp was held for over 1,100 children from 36 countries, not letting the situation thwart the mission. This year, trips are planned to Honduras, Taiwan, Cambodia, Nepal, and Paraguay continuing our vision to have a camp within 300 miles of every person on the planet.
