Swamp Camp Services Virtual Camp Participant & Parent:

I have read and agree to all of the following:

Mandatory Reporting

- I understand that Camp Swamp and all of its volunteers and employees are required by law to report any suspicion or evidence of sexual or physical abuse to the Department of Family Services or appropriate authorities where the camper lives, which will be handled discretely and personally by the Director.

Terms of Acceptance

- I understand the Director reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose behavior/attitude is disruptive or detrimental to the welfare of a camper or to the Swamp, or to the virtual camp experience. No refund will be given in the event of dismissal.
- I understand that no part of the virtual camp experience may be recorded any participant and subsequently used for private or public display. Failure to adhere to this may result in legal action and being barred from all future Swamp virtual or in-person camp activities.
- I authorize the appropriate and positive use of my child's photograph for promotional purposes as used by our professional staff (i.e. website, social media, etc.).

Waiver of Liability

- I, as a parent or guardian of the camper registered, do hereby give my permission for the camper to attend and participate in all activities at Camp Swamp/Swamp Camp Services, Inc., via its Virtual Camp experience. To the extent permitted by law, I agree not to hold Camp Swamp/Swamp Corps/Swamp Camp Services, Inc., its camp employees and volunteers, and all individuals associated with the program liable for any injury or harm to my child as a result of my child's participation in camp activities while my child is virtually participating.
